A Helping Hand in Unity

This weekend's second collection is for the Catholic Trust for England and Wales, *formerly the National Catholic Fund*. It costs over £1.6 million to fund the work of the Secretariat to the Bishops' Conference which helps to promote the life and service of the Catholic Church in our country. The highest contributor to the Fund is the Diocese of Westminster at 15% of the total. As a diocese we contribute the second highest sum at 9% of the total. Please remember that whenever we take up a second collection for our diocese it is an expression of the unity and communion between the diocese and our parish. This particular collection expresses the communion between all the dioceses in the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales so do please be as generous as you can in these hard times, as our diocese needs to raise at least £140,000.

A Helping Hand at Home

As a parish we owe a great debt to all those people over the years that have helped out, and continue to help out, in volunteering with the working life of the parish. Having said farewell to Celia MacPherson a little while ago on her retirement from active parish work, Mary Veerapen will also be retiring from parish work after many years of devoted service.
