As a Church we do want to celebrate how we work together but on a down side I have some unfortunate news ...

Will parents please supervise their children at all times and not leave them unattended anywhere within the church or hall grounds. Last week further vandalism occurred in both the church and hall. In the church toilet **someone found it funny to rip up all the toilet paper** and leave it in heaps on the floor and in the hall **someone had drawn in felt tip in a large area on the floor**, probably by a child left to draw by themselves.
