Parish Youth Group

Thank you to all those who came along to our pizza and games evening for those who were recently Confirmed - we hope to meet up again in September so please look in the newsletter for further news.

I think you'll agree that the **Garden and Hall work** we commissioned from Stephen O'Connor's company **London Garden Maintenance** has shown a great improvement not only to the safety of our garden area but to its overall improvement too. Stephen is a parishioner and I can heartily recommend him, so please see Fr Adrian if you would like further details.

At last! Thanks to a generous donation from a parishioner **we now have hot water back in the Hall** (just in time for our multi-faith celebration this evening!) David Madigan from **Madigas Services – 020 8645 9542** – was recommended by a parishioner and has done some excellent work. He has removed the faulty water heater, put in new gas plumbing for a future central-heating system, has provided a new economic 'combi-boiler' in the kitchen and repaired the faulty taps in the ladies loo. We now have 'instant' hot water which means you let the taps run for a bit and the hot water is provided directly from the boiler rather than a reservation tank so please be patient – the hot water will be there!

Refreshments will be available during the summer after the Family Mass, so do please swap with someone if you can't make your Sunday on the helpers' rota. **Thanks to all who help in providing the refreshments** as it is a great act of hospitality and it is important to keep such a welcome going throughout the year.
