October Celebrations

As in May, **the month of October is traditionally a time to focus on the care of Our Blessed Mother** and to particularly ask for her intercession in drawing us to the heart of her beloved Son. **Each Monday we hold a time of prayer and exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** directly after Mass until **Benediction** at noon, followed by the recitation of the **Rosary and our St Jude Novena**. All are welcome to attend and are especially encouraged to join us in praying the Rosary during this Marian month. In recognition of this, we'll be singing the **Salve Regina** at the end of all our Masses this month in preparation for the month of November when we'll be particularly focussing on praying for our dear departed.

At the end of October, when much of the world turns to Halloween thoughts of wizards, witches, and ghosts, the Church has a more positive way to celebrate and remember our past by focussing on the Saints who provide such an example to us (All Saints Day) and by praying for those who have died (All Souls Day). This year **our Buzz group will be hosting an All Saints Party in the Parish Hall from 3pm to 5pm on Saturday 31st October**. Instead of the negative aspects of Halloween we'll be focussing on the positive nature of our faith and invite all the **children of the parish to dress as angels or their favourite saints** and come along to the party. To cover the cost of the event there'll be an entrance fee of £3 with drinks and snacks provided, lots of seasonal games (apple bobbing etc.) and the opportunity to win some small prizes. All the parish children are invited and tickets will be available through the Buzz group or at the door on the day. We look forward to seeing you there. God bless, *Fr Adrian*.
