ONE SUNDAY FOR THE WHOLE WORLD

This Sunday, Pope Benedict XVI calls every Catholic to celebrate our vocation to be a missionary on World Mission Sunday. As Catholics around the world gather at the table of the Lord, we are to pray for the Church's worldwide missionary work. We pray for those awaiting the "Good News" of our Lord's great love for us and for the missionaries who offer the poor and suffering the light of Christ. We are also asked to offer financial help through our second collection today and in our continued support of the 'APF Red Boxes'. Money collected on World Mission Sunday goes towards helping: 83,000 priests, 455,000 religious and 1,700,000 catechists. Through them the APF supports 194,855 schools, 5,246 hospitals, 17,530 dispensaries, 577 leprosy centres, and 80,560 social and charitable institutions: your money really does go far! **[If you do have a Red Collection Box, or would like one, please see the notice overleaf.]**

At the end of this month our Buzz group will be hosting an **All Saints Party in the Parish Hall** from **3pm to 5pm on Saturday 31st October**.
