### A Saint for Our Times...

A number of our parishioners went either to Aylesford Priory or to Westminster Cathedral to visit the relics of St Therese – the 'Little Flower' and a saint of our times. The life of St Therese and indeed the visit of the relics have touched the lives of many so this week's newsletter includes an account from a volunteer from our parish who helped out one day...

On Tuesday, 13th October, I was asked to help with selling roses and candles to the pilgrims visiting Westminster Cathedral. I started after 5 pm and during the hours that followed hundreds of people arrived from all walks of life and nationalities - families with children, teenagers and the elderly, priests and nuns, people with disabilities and those popping in from work. They never stopped coming, queuing all through the chilly evening, chatting away, watching the big-screen in the plaza, and on finally arriving near to the Relics, the atmosphere seemed charged with reverence and awe at being so close to this great saint. As I left at 11 pm, the queue still stretched around the Cathedral - hundreds waiting to honour St Therese - testimony, in this secular and wounded world, to faith and a hunger for spirituality. It was truly a faith-filled event.

Just a reminder again that our Buzz group will be hosting an All Saints Party in the Parish Hall from 3pm to 5pm on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October — where all the children of the parish are invited to dress as angels or their favourite saints.
