We Will Remember Them

They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old:

Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn.

At the going down of the sun and in the morning

many people's lives throughout the world today.
Yet, the sacrifice of the 'Fallen' is not in vain, as
their memory serves to raise up people of peace
in each new generation to forge a better world,
striving to challenge the violence, injustice and
greed that destroys so many lives.

In the parish of St. Simon and St. Jude we walk
in the shadow of those parishioners who lost
their lives in the bombing raids of World War II,
of those who died in its battles and, in particular,
of the twelve men of our parish who died in the
'Great War':
