Offering up the Mass

Do please remember to place your **November Lists** and **Holy Souls Intentions** in the collection box at the foot of the altar, as these lists will be remembered at each Mass in November. Paper for the lists and Mass Intention envelopes are available at the church entrance. Each person can offer up their prayers in Mass for particular intentions and each Mass brings these prayers to the Lord. As a parish we offer a particular intention at each Mass following the Church's tradition of making a donation to personally support the work of the priest. Masses are offered for many reasons, such as the November List of Holy Souls, for someone who is sick, in memory of someone who has died, or perhaps as a birthday remembrance or simply to thank God for blessings received. It is important to pray for people and remember them on such occasions and having a Mass offered is a lovely way to show your care in asking for the Lord's blessing at a time of need.

Sadly, in common with many churches in the UK we receive very few Mass intention requests – currently five people in our parish provide all the intentions we receive. Do please consider requesting a particular Mass intention and if you have a special date, please give three to six month's notice as Sunday Masses are often requested; however Masses during the week are less frequently asked for, and you do not have to be present at the Mass for the intention to be said. Offerings can be made using the Mass Intention envelopes available in the church porch and Mass cards can be obtained from Fr Adrian as required. Thank you for your prayerful support. *Fr Adrian*

It's a joy to celebrate our diversity as we gather together at the weekend, each with our own gifts and strengths, but for people who are new or are unfamiliar with the parish, the characteristics of our church can be quite different: where are the hymn books? Why is there no organist? What happens at Little Church? Where's the Crying Chapel? We can make our church feel even more welcoming by greeting people at the door and helping them with practical matters, such as showing people to a seat when the church seems crowded, letting them know where the loo is, for example. Such a team of Welcomers would be a great addition to each Mass so I'm asking this weekend for people to volunteer to help with this important ministry of hospitality and welcome: please see me after Mass if you can help in any way.
