## Collections

Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised.

**£494.90** for the running of the Parish and

**£548.72** for CAFOD's Haiti disaster relief

*These sums include monies given in **Gift Aid**  
envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate  
by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.*

**This week's Gospel reminds us that we are sent  
out, like Jesus, to bring the good news of the  
Lord's comfort and relief to the downtrodden.  
Our second collection last week raised money for  
CAFOD's urgent relief work in Haiti and we will  
again be helping to raise funds for their vital  
contribution in our collection this week. St Paul  
reminds us in our second reading that we are the  
body of Christ: 'if one part is hurt, all parts are hurt  
with it', so do please consider what you can give to  
our second collection today. Thank you.**

As the Body of Christ we all have different gifts that  
are built up together to help build the Church and  
support the parish. Some people help in visible  
ministries within the parish, others in ways that most  
of the people who attend Mass do not see, but **we are  
all called to help use our time, our talents and our  
treasures (the gifts the Lord has given us) to help  
serve the Lord and one another.** The messages of  
our scriptures today are a timely reminder that we  
have only 5 readers at the Vigil Mass and 4 at the  
12.15. We are blessed with more readers at the  
10.30 Mass, so that they read only once in every ten  
weeks! As for the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy  
Communion, we have only 4 at the Vigil Mass, 5 at  
the 12.15 and 8 at the 10.30, meaning that, as we  
require 2 or 3 ministers at each Mass, they are called  
upon quite frequently. Such ministry is important,  
however frequently we serve and in whatever way, as  
we have others, again small in number, who help with  
our Welcome ministry, with the cleaning, collecting,  
counting, our Little Church, the sacristy, the flowers,  
the website, serving the refreshments and serving at  
Mass – **thank you to all who serve the Lord!**
