This Saturday our Faith Enquiry group journeyed to our Diocesan Cathedral, St. George's, to celebrate the 'Rite of Election' – the formal call of the four members of our parish who will be confirmed as adults this Easter – the Rite of Election is an ancient ceremony for those who as adults have responded to God's call (election) and have chosen to live out their faith as Catholic Christians. The ceremony sees both catechumens (those who are preparing to be baptised) and candidates (those who are already baptised) being "sent forth" by our Auxiliary Bishops to prepare to be received into parish churches across the Diocese of Southwark at Easter.

The whole diocese is asked to pray for the Elect and the Candidates, especially as they begin their period of final preparation for the celebration of the Sacraments, so do please pray for **Virginie** who will be baptised, confirmed and receive Holy Communion at Easter, **Victoria and Aleksandra** who will be confirmed and **Tracy** who will be confirmed and receive Holy Communion:

**"God of love and power,  
it is your will to establish everything in Christ  
and to draw us into his all-embracing love.  
Guide these chosen members of our parish family  
strengthen them in their vocation,  
build them into the kingdom of your Son  
and seal them with the Spirit of your promise.  
We ask this through Christ our Lord."**

As outlined over the last few weeks, please join in this celebration of our parish life by bringing along some food to share together so that we can **reflect on the joys and needs of our parish and have a meal together in the hall at 7.30pm on Saturday 27 February.**



Our thanks go to Jeff D'Rozario who has helped to develop the parish network and sound system by donating some equipment and guiding the purchase of supplementary equipment for the hall which will be used at the parish celebration and future events. **We've made some further changes to the loop system to try and make the sound clearer, so do please let Fr Adrian know if you notice the difference.**

The Parish Celebration will look at all aspects of Parish life but I'm keen that we develop our youth work. **I hope that we can organize a monthly youth night on a Friday for the older teens/younger twenties** and that the young people themselves can help run the night and choose what activities they'd like to do (e.g. film-making, music, DVDs, games, food etc.) This can only work if the families and youth of the Parish support it, so all **Parish Youth in their teens and twenties** (together with friends they might like to invite from Confirmation age and upwards) are invited to come along to the **Parish Hall on Friday 26th February from 7.30 to 9.00pm.** Refreshments will be available, but please come along with ideas as to how we can develop a creative and entertaining night that helps the Catholic youth of our Parish feel at home.
