News this week

Congratulations to all the young members of our Parish in year Six who will have heard of their Secondary School placements this week. Please continue to keep in your prayers the many younger members of our parish who have applied for Nursery and Primary School placements.

Thank you to all the members of our Parish who were able to join the Celebration last Saturday. We're very fortunate to have a growing Parish and over the next few months will be developing a Parish Team (a sort of Parish Council) to help us further reflect and grow as a Parish and lead us in practical ways.

LENTEN DEVOTIONS: As last year there is the opportunity for the celebration of the **Stations of the Cross** after Mass on Friday mornings and **volunteers are needed to coordinate this.** If enough volunteers came forward we may be able to hold them on a Friday evening but that is not possible with current numbers. **Please note that during Lent from 10-11am on Mondays Fr Adrian will be leading a series of scriptural reflections during Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament,** so do please make an extra sacrifice in Lent to come along to adore the Lord and reflect on his Word. Benediction and Rosary will continue from noon as normal during this time.



A BIG THANK YOU to a couple of volunteers from the Parish who are helping to refurbish the interior of the hall. You may have noticed the peeling wallpaper and holes in the walls (but please don't add to them!) so gradually these will disappear and, in time, we'll start on the outside of the hall too.

Thank you, as always, for your contributions to the Parish collections. Our second over the next couple of weeks goes to support our Parish maintenance programme. Please remember if you contribute via the Gift Aid scheme to use the envelopes provided at the entrance to the church. To help plan your giving please take enough envelopes home for the month so that you can complete the details of the envelope beforehand and bring them with you to church.

PRAYING FOR THE SICK – Please remember that there is a file in the porch where you can request prayers for those in need: the sick and housebound are very much at the heart of the church and support us in their prayers as we do them.

SUPPORTING OUR PARISH COLLECTION

Please give what you can to the parish collections each week, as more money is spent in the upkeep of the church than we receive. If you can, please give upwards of one hour of your weekly income and please consider if you're able to help join one of the parish groups, e.g. counters, cleaners, refreshment team, etc. If you are a UK tax payer please also consider setting up a Gift Aid payment direct to the church bank account. Thank you for your generosity. **A proportion of our first collection goes directly to support the work of our Diocese, with all monies raised in our second collection going to the particular cause each week. Thank you.**
