## Over the next couple of weeks...

The joy of the celebration of Easter is almost upon us  
and next week we celebrate Passion Sunday or Palm  
Sunday as it has become known. On that day we  
hear the Lord's Passion recited in preparation for the  
'Triduum' of Holy Week – the 'Three Day' celebration  
of the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday,  
the Solemn Liturgy of Good Friday and our joyful  
celebration of the light of the Lord that begins our Vigil  
and the celebration of Easter.

Our 10.30 Family Mass next Sunday begins down in  
the hall where we'll gather with palms and process  
back up to the church to commemorate the Lord's  
triumphal entry into Jerusalem, formally marking the  
beginning of our Holy Week services. If the journey to  
and from the hall would be difficult please remain in  
the church but otherwise do please join us in the hall  
for the special start to our Mass. Please note that for  
that week only Little Church will start in the hall and  
remain there after the palm procession to rejoin us in  
the church as usual after 11am.

This Thursday we celebrate the Annunciation of Our  
Lord but it has not been possible to alter the Parish  
diary so, as usual, the church will be closed on  
Thursday. However, the Mass of the Annunciation  
will be celebrated at 9.30am either at St Matthew's,  
West Norwood or English Martyrs, Streatham.

Please note that Mass on Friday will be a Requiem  
Mass at 9.30am for the repose of the soul of Elizabeth  
Hibberd. All are welcome and please keep Elizabeth  
and her family in your prayers. Please also pray for  
the repose of the soul of Helen Rushworth who died  
recently and whose funeral will be celebrated in

Lunch will be hosted on 29<sup>th</sup> March instead of 5<sup>th</sup> April as the church will be closed on the Bank Holiday. Do please join us to help provide meals for children in some of the poorest parts of Africa.

In addition to the help needed from our Readers and Extraordinary Ministers, **will our Altar Servers please sign-up to help out over Holy Week.** During the Triduum (Thursday-Friday-Saturday of Holy Week) **we need at least eight servers for each service** so do please help to serve the Lord at the altar at this special time. Thank you.

**Our next Buzz Club** for children aged 7-12 meets in the Parish Hall on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> March from 6-7.30pm.
