




News this week

Thank you for your kindness and generosity this Easter. Since the very earliest days of the Church it has always been the responsibility of the local church to care for its ministers and indeed our parish has to be entirely self-funding for all its needs. The collections we take each Sunday are there to fund the life of the parish (I can assure you they're not simply there to fund the life of the parish priest), with our second collections each week either going directly to particular charities or to the repair and maintenance programme of the parish.

Only twice a year, at Easter and Christmas, is the collection given to the priest, as this forms the basis of how a priest supports himself throughout the year without the benefit of a salary, as parish priests in our Diocese are unwaged. It is a personal honour to be able to help lead such a busy and growing parish – growing so much so that we're often standing-room only at our Family Mass! It's a joy to be able to help bring renewal to our parish – we've come a long way in under two years and we've got a long way to go yet, but to see how much we're growing and how much the fabric of the hall and church is changing is a

real blessing. So thank you for all the blessings that you are to me in your prayers and support, for all that you've done in the past and for all that we can accomplish together in the future. May we truly know the blessings and joy of the Risen Lord in the time ahead. God bless, for Adrian.
