Election News - On Wednesday 21 April from 7.45-9.30pm there will be a 'Streatham Hustings' at Streatham Baptist Church, 22 Lewin Road, where **four local parliamentary candidates will be present to answer any and all questions you may have concerning their views, policies and intentions for Streatham.** Please come along with questions ready as you arrive so that our local neighbourhood can truly have a voice in the election process. The next day **Faiths Together in Lambeth** will be holding a General Election Meeting on **Thursday 22 April from 7-9pm at the Karibu Centre**, 7 Gresham Road, Brixton, SW9 7PH. The Conservative, Green, Labour and Liberal candidates for the parliamentary constituencies in the Borough of Lambeth (Dulwich & West Norwood, Streatham, and Vauxhall), are being invited to participate. The aim will be to articulate the concerns of Lambeth's faith communities through the opportunity of a 'question and answer' session. **From the perspective of our Catholic faith** our Bishops have produced a document called *Choosing the Common Good* which presents some of the principles and values by which the Church seeks to construct a just and civil society. This document is freely available via the internet.
