**I am delighted to inform you that the Holy Father
has appointed Archbishop Peter Smith as our new
Archbishop in succession to Archbishop Kevin.**
Archbishop Peter's roots are in the Southwark
diocese. He was born in Battersea on 21st October
1943 and educated at Clapham College. He was
ordained for Southwark on 5th July 1972 and after
various appointments in the Diocese was appointed
Bishop of East Anglia in 1995 and Archbishop of
Cardiff in 2001. Speaking of his appointment,
Archbishop Peter said: "I shall never forget the
warmth and generosity of the people of Wales
...However, my sadness at leaving is tempered by the
prospect of returning to my roots in South London and
going home to the Archdiocese in which I was born
and for which I was ordained a priest in 1972. I am
very much looking forward to that and to serving the
people, religious, deacons and priests of the
Archdiocese of Southwark as their Bishop." Please
pray for Archbishop Peter in preparation for his return
to the diocese and for Archbishop Kevin in his
continued convalescence.
