These sums include monies given in Gift Aid envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.

As you will have heard by now, **Pope Benedict XVI** is to visit England and Scotland from 16–19 September. As this is a State Visit, and much shorter than the pastoral visit of Pope John Paul II in 1982, it will be quite a different experience, but I will publish the details as soon as any London events are announced. So far it is hoped that the Holy Father will proclaim the Beatification of Cardinal John Henry Newman in Coventry, celebrate public Mass in Glasgow and hold a prayer vigil in London.

These events will inevitably involve major expense and the Bishops' Conference has already raised the major part of the funds, however, there will be a collection taken in the churches of England, Wales and Scotland today to help meet the costs. Each diocese has a target figure in order to raise £1m from England and Wales. Our target as a Diocese is approximately £87,000 and since this is considerably more than we would normally raise through a second collection, each Parish is asked to support this special occasion through their prayers and generosity. Please do consider giving more than you might normally give to our second collection this week. Thanks you as always, for your prayers and generosity at all our Masses.
