Collections

Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised **£381.13** for the running of the parish **£278.17** for the Parish Maintenance Programme *These sums include monies given in **Gift Aid** envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.*

Alive and Active Too

Last week we were reminded of how the New Testament describes God's Word as "alive and active" in the heart of our being [Hebrews 4:12] and the hope that as a Parish we will always take God's Word to heart and live our lives as the Body of Christ, using our Time, our Talents and our Treasures (our monetary gifts) to help nurture our individual lives and to help build up our Parish life. One of the ways we help to care for the needs of the Parish is through the **Gift Aid scheme**. If you haven't signed up to Gift Aid and are a UK tax-payer please consider doing so, as currently for every qualifying pound given we get 28 pence back from the Inland Revenue – a letter explaining Gift Aid with the necessary forms is available at the back of the church if you'd like more information. A **BIG THANK YOU** to all those who contributed through Gift Aid last year as we raised nearly £32,000 which means that the Government will give us a further £9000 at no extra cost to the original donors. **If you do Gift Aid your donations please remember to use a Gift Aid envelope as even a donation of a pound becomes £1.28 and all those pennies add up – thank you!** All the ways we give as a Parish help to build God's Kingdom and **this weekend our Second Collection goes to help the mission of the White Fathers** who help build God's Kingdom in partnership with the Church in Africa. The White Fathers are involved in parish work, justice and peace campaigns, education and social welfare. Please remember that donations for our First and Second Collections can be Gift Aided so this week the White Fathers can gain extra monies from any donations that have been Gift Aided in our Second Collection. After the event our Ladies' Prayer and Social Group will be meeting, so **do please join us from 8 to 9pm.**
