Further News on the Visit of Pope Benedict XVI

For the last three weeks now our Parish, together with Parishes up and down the country have had the opportunity to become part of Pope Benedict's historic state visit and pilgrimage to our country. Sadly, we live in an age where a high level of security is needed, so entry to all the services during the Papal visit is by Pilgrim Pass only. The central office organizing the passes don't seem to have given us much time, nevertheless, all applications must be finalized this week. Each Parish has an allocated number of Pilgrim Passes available but these are not transferable and are issued to named individuals only. I am saddened that many people took application forms and did not return them by the closing date, denying passes to other Parishioners. Our pilgrim numbers were given to the Papal Visit Coordinator this week but **I have arranged for more application forms to be available this weekend for those who do want to take part in the pilgrimage either to Hyde Park on Saturday 18th or to Birmingham on Sunday 19th September.**

Please complete these forms with payment (cash or cheque) and return them through the letter box of the Priest's House by 6pm **this Sunday 1st August** so that I can send all the names and details to the Papal Visit Coordinator without further delay.
