Pakistan Flood Appeal

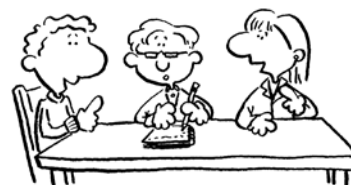
Thank you for responding to our appeal for the disaster in Pakistan. CAFOD have already given £100,000 towards the emergency relief work and are distributing aid directly through their partner charity CRS (Catholic Relief Services). CRS is based in Pakistan and has distributed vital supplies including plastic sheeting, water purification tablets and other relief items. Aid workers are reaching those in desperate need that have been cut off from outside help for days and the funds that we have raised will go towards these efforts – thank you.
