Marian Month of Mission

October is traditionally seen as a month especially devoted to the intercessory prayers of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is also a month of mission where we are called to consider Jesus' call to bring God's Word to the whole world. This call, known from Matthew's Gospel as the Great Commission (Mt 28:19-20) is clarified in Luke's Gospel as 'beginning from Jerusalem' (Lk 24:47), in other words, starting from where the disciple were. Our commission is the same: we are called to witness to God's loving care to those around us by the example of our lives. To witness "where we are" can also be taken to mean "where we're at" in life. A pop song in the charts a few years ago cried out "where's your head at" which begs the question where each of us is in our own response to God's call: how we respond to His reaching out to us in love and mercy; how we respond to the call of a moral life – to live out the Commandments – and how we respond to the call to reach out to others; in short, how each of us responds to the call of our baptism to shine out with the light of Christ to others. The Christian life never promises to be an easy one and many struggle to live out the Commandments and the Church's teaching; yet the Great Commission is the call to God's love and mercy, to the Passion of His Son and our passion for Christ in return. At the foot of the cross Jesus gave his mother to be Our Mother and it is in Mary's "Yes" to God's call and in the pain of the cross that our own struggles can be cradled. Mary's prayers always lead us to the heart of her Son so, especially in this month of October, may we ask for Mary's intercession in our own pains and struggles and, especially, for those who need our prayers. God bless, *Fr. Adrian.*
