## Collections

## School Application Difficulties

At this time of year many parents grow anxious about the process of applying for school places for their children. Catholic Schools throughout the land are renowned for their standards of education and the tremendous pastoral support that is given in the name of Our Lord. Faith schools have been criticised by some as being too selective and only taking the 'best of the bunch' but that is far from the truth – all Catholic schools have an open admissions policy and the fundamental basis of selection is purely whether a person is a faithfully-attending baptised member of the Church – no schools have a policy of selecting on the basis of social standing or background as this would be against the Social teaching of the Church. Sadly, the majority of difficulties in school applications stem from the lack of places available and I have been battling with this issue since my arrival here over two years ago. I met briefly with our area Bishop Pat Lynch and Chuka Umunna the local MP this week to set up a joint meeting as part of our Parish schools campaign and I will bring further news when I have it. In short, the best way of obtaining a place in a Catholic School is to whole-heartedly practice your faith by coming to Mass each Sunday and by helping your child to grow in their faith through Bible stories at home and faithful attendance at Mass and (depending on age) our Little Church. **NB: any parent seeking a reference for a place in a Catholic school should see me before stating me as a referee**, as there is a Parish Form I need to be completed for information beforehand. **At such a time of stress for many, let us ask for the Blessed Virgin Mary's intercession, as her mother's heart reaches out to all in need.** With my prayers as ever, God bless, *Fr. Adrian.*

If we are to do this however we need the donation of fireworks and some adult volunteers so Fr Adrian is asking for help.** As with each First Friday our Confirmation Programme is held as part of **Youth Club** night and **all secondary school-aged children are invited to attend.** As we'll be having some hot food to keep us warm that night as well as the fireworks **there is a reply-slip at the back of church, if you would like to come along please return this by 31 October** so that we can have an idea of numbers to cater for.

Our next Parish fund-raising event is an **Autumn Food Fare** on Saturday 13 November. We'll have our very own **TV chef** coming to give a cooking demonstration, will be able to sit down to a meal of the delicious food that's been prepared and have the chance to buy some home-baked goodies along with a prize raffle and bottle tombola. **To do this we need the entire parish to help** so please donate bottles of drink (both alcoholic and non-alcoholic) and unopened store-bought gifts to use as raffle prizes. These items can be placed in the box that will be available at the front of the church over the next few weeks.
