### Remember, Remember...

Christian views on Halloween have been in the news over the last week: instead of focussing on wizards, witches and commercialism (the negative aspects of Halloween), children should be encouraged to remember that **All Hallow's Eve** means literally, "the night before **All Saints Day**". Remembering the lives of the Saints encourages us to focus on positive aspects rather than grabbing goodies through 'trick or treat' and helps us to remember **our own call in life is not to get out of it as much as we can**, but rather to serve the Lord and one another. **On 31<sup>st</sup> October, All Saints Day, we invite everyone at Mass, especially the children of the parish, to dress as their favourite saints or angels** and be a positive witness to the real meaning of Halloween.

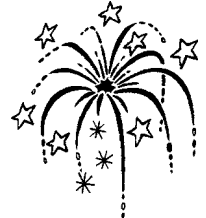

The first Friday of each month is a youth night in our Parish and, as the first Friday next month is **5<sup>th</sup> November**, that evening will be **open to all Parish families to join us from 6.30-7.30pm** for some **hot food and a fireworks display**. If you would like to come along please return the reply-slips that are available in the church porch. In order to cater for the food and fireworks we're asking for donations of £5 per person or the equivalent of £5 of fireworks per person.
