## Collections

Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised  
**£237.44** for the running of the parish and  
**£221.38** for the Parish Refurbishment Programme  
*These sums include monies given in **Gift Aid**  
envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate  
by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.*

**Thank you, as always, for how your sacrificial giving  
keeps our Parish running. Sadly, with many people  
away over the holidays and the combination of the  
bad weather in December, our collections have been  
drastically reduced. If you have been away and are  
able to continue to support the Parish through your  
sacrificial giving, you may add any un-donated  
contributions to this Sunday's collection. Sacrificial  
giving is part of our Christian way of life, when we  
are able to recognize that the giving of our time,  
of our talents and gifts and of our financial  
resources, stems from our individual response to  
God's grace in our lives. Each of us is called to give  
out of our own circumstances but when people ask  
"What should I give to the collection?" a Biblical  
guide would be to give upwards of 10% of your total  
weekly income. Some people think of their giving in  
terms of the equivalent of an hour's wage or income,  
but both guidelines reflect that some people are able  
to give more than others because they earn more  
than others: please remember we're not called to  
give the same amount as other people. In writing to  
the church at Corinth St Paul advises us...**

"Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap  
sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap  
generously. Each person should give what he has decided  
in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for  
God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all  
grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having  
all that you need, you will abound in every good work.  
As it is written: He has scattered abroad his gifts to the  
poor; his righteousness endures for ever." 2 Co. 9:6-9

**The year ahead is going to have plenty of challenges  
for us all, but with God's help and our determination,  
we can see our own families and our Parish family  
grow in God's grace and have the strength to face  
what joys and difficulties this new year has in store.**
