This Sunday the dioceses of England and Wales are marking the World Day of Prayer for Peace, transferred from 1st January. The Holy Father has chosen 'Religious Freedom, the Path to Peace' as the theme this year. It is also the World Day for Migrants and Refugees, with the Holy Father having chosen the theme 'One human family'. Bishop Patrick Lynch, Chairman of the Office for Migration Policy of our Catholic Bishops' Conference, has reflected on the issues raised by the Holy Father and says that the Holy Father 'reminds us that because of globalization and migration we are becoming increasingly inter-connected and more conscious than ever that all of us belong to one human family. An important aspect of the mission of the Church in the world today is, therefore, to be a sign and instrument of union with God and of the unity of the whole human race.' Let us take some time this weekend to reflect that we form one human family and need to pray and work for justice and peace for all.
