Throughout the UK churches are celebrating Christian Unity week. In the spirit of these celebrations St. Leonard's in Streatham has contacted us for help with their project of a public reading of the whole of the King James Bible. Their aim is to gather a group of volunteers who can read a chapter at a time so that a host of volunteers can be chosen to read at a set time either between 3-5pm or 6-8pm on Thursdays from 3 February to 24 November. A sign-up sheet is available in the porch which will be collected next by Revd. Lisa Wright next week. If you would like to be involved in this project it doesn't mean that you have to read each week, you just read the chapter you are allocated and if you like you can request a preference for a particular passage. **The sign-up sheet is next to our prayer request sheet by the welcome board.**

This Sunday is Holocaust Memorial Day. Lambeth Council hold an annual commemorative event to honour the survivors of genocide across the globe. If you would like to attend, the event is being held from 3-5pm in the Assembly Hall of Lambeth Town Hall.

On Saturday 12th February from 12-3pm we are holding a *Family Fare* with a prize raffle, delicious sandwiches, scones and cakes and a host of activities for children including competitions, card



making, cookie decorating, face & nail painting, a Punch and Judy show and a big-screen cinema.
