Collections

Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised **£584.82** for the running of the parish and **£292.16** for the Parish Refurbishment Programme. *These sums include monies given in **Gift Aid** envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.*

Last week we began a series of leaflets looking at the parts of the Mass. This week we turn our attention to the **Introductory Rites**. At the beginning of Mass we make the sign of the cross, reminding us how set aside this special time in the week and gather in the name of the Holy Trinity, openly acknowledging God's presence with us at the start of Mass as we respond to the declaration: "The Lord be with you...". In itself, this action marks out our time together as a holy moment, echoing the words of Jesus, "For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them" (Mt 18:20). We come together to listen to God's word and, by being in a state of grace, to be nourished by Christ's body and blood in Holy Communion, so that we can receive God's strength to be the sign of Christ's presence in the world, serving and caring not just our own families, but the community around us.

The Introductory Rites of the Mass help to bring us together as the Body of Christ: the opening antiphon or hymn helps to create a sense of identity and, by our participation, shows our willingness to celebrate and an awareness of the journey in faith we share together. The Penitential Act emphasises that journey of faith as we recognise our need of God's loving forgiveness for times when we stray on that journey and, in our Gloria, acknowledge God's loving mercy in Christ who takes "away the sin of the world..." By acknowledging that we gather in God's name, in the glory of his love and mercy, the opening parts of the Mass 'put us in our place' in the best possible way and prepare us to hear God speak to us through the Liturgy of the Word, the subject of next week's leaflets.
