Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised

£482.60 for the running of the parish and

£483.48 for the CAFOD Fast Day

These sums include monies given in Gift Aid envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.

Thank you for helping to raise the wonderful sum of nearly £500 for our CAFOD Fast Day collection last week. Taking time to fast during Lent is an important part of our Christian tradition, not only from the spiritual value of fasting, but from the opportunity it gives us to help raise funds (Lenten Alms) from the money we might save by giving things up. As last year, our Lenten Alms will be shared between the Cabrini Children's Society and the needs of our own Parish youth so, if you're saving money [from not eating chocolate for example] please donate those savings into our alms box in front of the sanctuary to help raise funds for young people in need. Thank you.

Just a reminder... next Sunday we celebrate Mothers Day and at all our Masses mothers in our Parish will have the opportunity of taking a daffodil flower home with them as a gesture of love and thanks. At this time we especially remember all our dearly departed mothers: *may they rest in peace. Amen.*

As part of our Lenten prayers we will be saying the Stations of the Cross each Monday. Not everyone is able to join us then but, if you are free, do please consider joining us for the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament as part of your own prayers.
