John's Gospel speaks of Jesus as the Good Shepherd who lays down his life for his sheep and how we are called to listen to the voice of our guiding Shepherd. That is why this Sunday is chosen as **World Day of Prayer for Vocations to Priesthood and Religious Life** and is a day when our Second

Collection goes to support the Diocesan fund for training future Church leaders. **It is also the day when, at the 12.15 Mass, we celebrate children from our Parish making their First Holy Communion.** Such children are not just potential leaders in the Church of tomorrow – they are part of the Church today. John's Gospel tells us Jesus words: **"I have come so that they may have life and have it to the full"**. Let us pray that, through Christ's Sacrifice and the strength that comes to us through Holy Communion, our First Holy Communion children and all the children of our parish will be strengthened in their spiritual life and know the fullness of God's love for them.
