Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised **£382.61** for the running of the parish

**As you'll understand**, I don't announce that the Priest's House may be empty (for obvious reasons of safety), but I'm very grateful to Fr. Gibbons for celebrating Mass here last weekend whilst I was away on pilgrimage in the Holy Land. You were in my prayers during the day and at Mass, traveling with me as I visited such wonderful sights as the Church of the Nativity of our Lord, Bethlehem and Nazareth; the Mount of Temptation; the Sea of Galilee; the Mount of the Beatitudes; the Garden of Gethsemane and the site of our Lord's crucifixion, burial and resurrection. **I hope to lead a Parish Pilgrimage to the Holy Land next November**, allowing time for people to save up for such a tremendous opportunity. **Last weekend we celebrated Corpus Christi - Being the Body of Christ to Others.** We celebrate being the Body of Christ together when we form one community at Mass; when we show care and concern to those in need and when we use our *Time, our Talents and our Treasures* in raising the vital funds that keep our Parish going. Without such funds our Parish would not be viable as we could not support the many charities we help as well as looking out for the needs of our own Parish. **We have to hold fund-raising events throughout the year as our Sunday collections bring in only a third of the income we need** but sadly, with just two weeks to go, only seven people so far have signed up to come to our summer fund-raising event.
