## **News this week:**

The Parish is holding a Gift Day to recognise and celebrate our individual gifts and talents on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> November and our Autumn Fare on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> November: please keep these dates free to join us.

**Fr. Adrian plans to lead a Parish Pilgrimage to the Holy Land in November 2012.** The trip would only be possible if we had a group of 20 people and the dates have been chosen to allow time for people to save up for such a tremendous opportunity. If you would like more information please pick up a leaflet from the porch. No deposit monies need be given in at the moment but please let Fr. Adrian know if you are keen so that he can arrange a get-together of all those interested to show a film of the pilgrimage sites.

**School Reference Forms** - If you have a child who will be starting Nursery or Reception or moving from Primary into Secondary or changing school in SEPTEMBER 2012 Catholic Schools will require you to have a reference from Fr. Adrian. **Such references are only given after parents have completed a Parish Application for a School Reference.** These application forms are only given out after Mass to the parents of children for whom they are required. The range of birth dates for forthcoming applications are:

**1st September 2000 to 31st August 2001 and 1st September 2007 to 31st August 2009.**

Please note: a reference can only be given after Fr. Adrian has received a completed Parish Application form for 2012. **Any request for a reference, such as the completion of a school form, should be made in writing and posted through the parish letterbox rather than given to Fr. Adrian at the end of Mass.** Please note: Following our School Places Campaign, St. Bede's is now our linked Primary School and our Parish is listed in the Application Criteria as a feeder Parish. This is a direct result of our appeal to the local authority, our MP and the School's Commission. Prior to this our Parish had no feeder status; this however, should not deter parents from applying to any local Catholic school and parents are best advised to apply to all Catholics schools in our local area.

Thank you, as always, for your contributions to the Parish collections. **Our second collection next week is for the Parish Refurbishment programme.** Please remember if you contribute via the Gift Aid scheme to use the envelopes provided at the entrance to the church. To help plan your giving please take enough envelopes home for the month so that you can complete the details of the envelope beforehand and bring them with you to church.

**PRAYING FOR THE SICK** Please remember that there is a file in the porch where you can request prayers for those in need: the sick and housebound are very much at the heart of the church and support us in their prayers as we do them.
