This weekend we begin to introduce the changes to our English translation of the Roman Missal – the prayer book we use during Mass. As part of these changes we're going to be singing some of the Mass parts at each Mass over the next couple of months. Singing not only helps us to memorise the lines more easily but helps us to participate more fully in those parts of the Mass that should ordinarily be sung anyway. We'll keep to the practice of having hymns at our Family Mass but the hymn books are now stored in the front porch so **please remember to take your hymn book to the bookcase** and not leave it in your seat for someone else to clear up. We'll be using new Mass cards for our responses at each Mass and these need to be stored in the Server's Sacristy (not in the hymn books).
