## Holy Week and Easter Celebrations

**Maundy Thursday: 8pm Mass of the Lord's Supper.**  
At this Mass the palm prayers we presented on Sunday are placed before the altar as a symbol of our service to the Lord in remembrance of Christ's service in washing the Apostles' feet. After Mass the tabernacle on the Sanctuary remains empty and we process to the Lady Chapel to join in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament at the Altar of Repose. Prayer will be guided by music and readings and will end at 10pm so please stay to the end if you are able.

#### **Good Friday: Services at 10am and 3pm**

Stations of the Cross will be held in the church at 10am, with refreshments available in the hall afterwards. The Solemn Liturgy for Good Friday will start at 3pm, including the Veneration of the Cross.

#### **Easter Vigil 8 pm Saturday 23 April**

Our Easter Mass begins at 8pm outside the Parish Hall, from where we'll process into the church. If the weather is awful we'll gather directly in the church.

The Gift Aid scheme is a benefit to the Parish as any tax claimed back does not go to Fr. Adrian but is used for the charitable work of the Church. Thank you for your generosity and support.
