**Please stand for** The Sequence – said together:  
**Christians, to the Paschal Victim offer sacrifice and praise. The sheep are ransomed by the Lamb; and Christ, the undefiled, hath sinners to his Father reconciled. Death with life contended: combat strangely ended! Life's own Champion, slain, yet lives to reign. Tell us, Mary: say what thou didst see upon the way. The tomb the Living did enclose;**

**I saw Christ's glory as he rose! The angels there attesting; shroud with grave-clothes resting. Christ, my hope, has risen: he goes before you into Galilee. That Christ is truly risen from the dead we know. Victorious king, thy mercy show!**

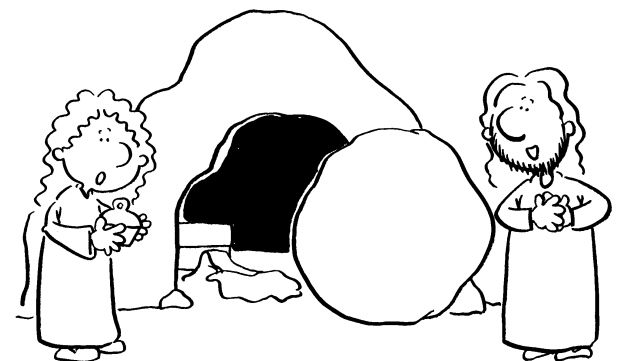
After the closing prayer: Fr. A: Go in peace, alleluia, alleluia.

Adrian is not employed by the parish, but is appointed by the Archbishop, receiving no salary but supported throughout the year by our Easter or Christmas offering. **If you haven't come prepared for today's gift please take an Easter Offering envelope home and bring this with you next time or consider posting your gift in an Easter card.** Please remember if you contribute via the Gift Aid scheme to state your name clearly on the envelope. The Gift Aid scheme is a benefit to the Parish as any tax claimed back does not go to Fr. Adrian but is used for the charitable work of the Church. Thank you for your generosity and support.

Next Sunday is **Divine Mercy Sunday** and there are many events celebrating this throughout the Diocese, including a **celebration at Aylesford Priory on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> April.** This will be led by Bishop Paul Hendricks and hosted by the Marian Fathers. The day begins at 10.30am with Gathering Prayers and a talk on Divine Mercy, followed by Mass at noon. There will be instruction on the Divine Mercy at 2pm followed by a Holy Hour with the Chaplet, Benediction and the veneration of the Image of our Merciful Jesus and the relics of St Faustina at 3pm.
