### Parish Campaign for School Places

Last week it was announced at Mass that the Governors of Corpus Christi School have removed our Parish from their admissions' preference criteria and that the Diocesan Schools Commission was in negotiation with Lambeth Council over proposals to build a new school south of the borough. Sadly, even if a future school is built it seems there will be no advantage to children from our parish, rather the opposite, with further disadvantage from yet another school being out of our area and unable to give priority to our Parish children. In order to show the need we have for school places for children from our Parish the Deanery is seeking the details of all schools currently attended by our Parish children. Although there is a shortage of Primary School places the population growth may well advance the need for Secondary School places as well, so **will all parents please take a survey form from the church porch and complete and return this to Fr. Adrian by 27 May.** This affects all Catholic families with school-aged children so **if you know of Catholic families who live in our area but do not attend Mass here,** please take a form for them and make sure they return it to me, as the more we can demonstrate our need for school places the stronger our argument becomes. Thank you for your support and, whether you have school-aged children or not, **please continue to pray for justice and that our voice may be heard.** Thank you, *Fr. Adrian*
