**Parish Campaign for School Places:** Thank you to those who returned the survey forms. Fr. Adrian met with the clergy and headteachers from our local Catholic Primary and Secondary Schools last week to address our concerns about the lack of school places to the Director of our Diocesan Education Commission. Negotiation between the Diocese and Lambeth Council about the provision of school places is on-going but our concerns will be taken into account. **Please keep in your prayers those children from our Parish who have yet to gain a place at school as Fr. Adrian has been attending school appeals with parish families. Thank you.**

The Knights of St. Columba plan to hold a **Dads 'n' Lads** event for **fathers and sons over 16** years of age from the local area with a BBQ and indoor/outdoor sports competitions: details are to follow as the date has had to change.
