## Collections

Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised **£351.40** for the charitable work of the Parish **£322.22** for the Parish Refurbishment programme *These sums include monies given in Gift Aid envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.*

In the current economic times, when bureaucratic bankers seem to be the only ones awash with funds and bonuses I believe in not spending money until it's absolutely needed and when we absolutely have it. These times are tough for all and many of us in the Parish Family are working very long hours for very little pay; nevertheless, just like 'the widow's mite', it is only thanks to some very generous donations and extreme cost-cutting that have we been able to continue to meet our needs. Our main source of income is our first collection but we never raise enough in that collection alone to meet all our outgoings and have to organise fundraisers like our recent sponsored walk. Although there are times when the second collection goes to helping with our Parish maintenance, every time we raise funds for other charities all of that money goes directly to the charity, such as Missio or CAFOD appeals and, next week, the Apostleship of the Sea.

In 2011 we had 383 registered parishioners giving, on average, £178 a year in the first collection. That's the equivalent of a little over £3.40 per week. Naturally, that amount doesn't include what's given in the second collection, but if we had to raise the funds for meeting our needs by the first collection alone, for the last two years we'd have raised only half the funds we needed and wouldn't be able to meet our bills. Thankfully, some people give far more than £3.40 a week to the first collection, but sadly many people give under that amount. *To meet just our basic bills each of us in the Parish would have to give, on average £7 per week to the first collection: that's each person, 52 weeks a year!* **Thank you for all the ways you give: of your time, your talents, and your treasures, not just for our first collection, but for many needs; but do please consider just how much we need your support as a Parish and just how much you can give yourself.**
