## Collections

Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised **£547.85** for the charitable work of the Parish and **£403.22** for the Refurbishment Programme *These sums include monies given in Gift Aid envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.*

### Using God's Gifts...

Over the last couple of weeks we've looked at how we can use our 'Time, Talents and Treasures' to help build God's Kingdom. Those three T's trip off the tongue but what does being a good steward of our *Time, Talents and Treasures* mean?

**TIME** - The ways we help build the Church by our personal involvement

**TALENTS** - The ways we use our gifts to help build the ministry of the Church

**TREASURES** - The ways we use our financial resources as a gift from God

All of us, young or old, new to our Christian faith or 'Cradle Catholic' are called to be followers - disciples - of the Lord and use the gifts God gives us the best way we can to build our family life, the life of the Church and the life of our community. As one of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vatican Council documents put it:

"In the various types and duties of life, one and the same holiness is cultivated by all who are moved by the Spirit of God, and who obey the voice of the Father, worshiping God and Father in spirit and in truth. These souls follow the poor Christ, the humble and cross-bearing Christ, in order to be made worthy of being partakers in His glory. Every person should walk unhesitatingly according to his own personal gifts and duties in the path of a living faith which arouses hope and works through charity." (Vatican Council II, *Lumen Gentium*, §41)

As a small Parish we're blessed each time we gather as a community, pooling the gifts we have and sharing together in the Eucharist and God's blessings to reach out in turn to those in need around us: thank you for being the gift of God that you are.
