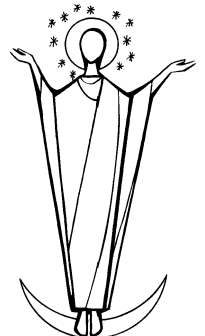
Collections
