First Holy Communion and Confirmation classes will be starting this autumn. If a child in your family is of an age where they could prepare for these sacraments please introduce yourself to Fr. Adrian after Mass. To make their First Holy Communion a child must be at least 7 years of age by March 1, 2013. To receive Confirmation a child should be 14 or over by June 2013. If you are an adult interested in preparing for the Sacraments please join our **Faith Enquiry Group** which begins on Tuesday 25 Sep. at 7.30pm.

If you have a child who will be starting Nursery/Reception, moving from Primary into Secondary or changing school in SEPTEMBER 2013 Catholic Schools will require you to have a reference from Fr. Adrian. **Such references are given after parents have completed a "Parish Application for a School Reference"**. Parents can collect these from Fr. Adrian after Mass but **any request for the completion of a school form should be made in writing and posted through the parish letterbox: please don't give them to Fr. Adrian before or after Mass.**
