**Thank you to those who were able to join us for our charity lunch last Monday.** On the first Monday of each month a small group of parishioners join together for a simple meal of soup and bread, making a donation towards **Mary's Meals**, a charity which you may have heard of in the press this week when a primary school girl went to Malawi to see where all the funds she had raised (over £100,000) were being used by the charity. Last year our small group of parishioners raised enough funds to feed 80 children for an entire year and this month alone we raised money to give 12 children a hot meal each day for the year ahead. You can find out more information about Mary's Meals on the board in the church. One of the other charities we support is **CAFOD** who celebrate their Harvest Fast this month. Envelopes are available in the porch for you to take home and consider how, by denying ourselves something we enjoy, we could give the amount we save towards their appeal. Please put your donations in the box at the front of the church. Donations can be made throughout the month of October which is devoted to Our Blessed Mother. **Do remember, we pray the Rosary each Monday** after Benediction so please join us if you can, and if not, why not consider making time to pray the Rosary as a family at some point during the month.
