These sums include monies given in Gift Aid envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.

Thank you to all those who have volunteered to bring some food and drink for our **Parish Celebration on Saturday 27 October for the feast of St Simon and St Jude**. Our Vigil Mass beforehand will highlight the different cultures and languages of our Parish Family and carry the celebration into the hall afterwards. **We're inviting parishioners to come along in their national dress, bringing with them their favourite dishes** so we can share together a family feast. Your contributions of food and drink can be brought to the Hall at 5.30pm if you're at the Vigil, otherwise the doors will open at 7 with food at 7.30pm. **This is a family event so children are very welcome** for all or some of the night, as we close at 10.30pm. Do please join us and invite friends and neighbours too so that they can celebrate with us. As well as your kind contributions of food and drink we will be asking for donations to help build the fire escape and will be holding a prize raffle that night towards these funds.

As a Parish during the Year of Faith we will be celebrating the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion, going on pilgrimage to the Holy Land, following the *Doorway to Faith* programme, and having the opportunity to host a time of prayer at home, gathering around the candle and picture blessed by Pope Benedict.

Thank you to the 20 families who have signed up to host the candle and picture so far, but we need a total of 55 hosts, so **please consider joining us in this circle of prayer that will make such a difference to our parish and to our homes. Thank you.**
