We will celebrate the first Mass of Christmas at a 6pm Family Mass on Monday 24th. Fr. Adrian is hoping that we can put on a nativity play at that Mass. There won't be any lines to learn as there's a musical backing track but we do need the typical cast of nativity characters from among our children and some volunteer parents to help rehearse and run-through the movement. Please see Fr. Adrian if you or our child would like to help.



It won't be long now until our Parish Pilgrims head to **the Holy Land for the Year of Faith.** Fr. Adrian has produced a prayer diary at the front of the sanctuary so please take a sheet home to join in the blessings of the pilgrimage by praying along with the pilgrims day by day. **PLEASE PRAY** for peace in the Middle East at such a difficult time. If the Foreign Office advises against travel sadly our pilgrimage will have to be cancelled. However, there are pilgrims currently in the Holy Land and the areas visited are nowhere near any trouble-spots.
