Thank you, for our collections last week, we raised **£393.34** for the charitable work of the Parish and **£295.18** for our Refurbishment Programme

Thank you to everyone who was able to pray for our Holy Land Pilgrimage. Despite the time of turmoil in the Middle East we were looked after at every stage and were blessed to arrive the same night that a ceasefire was declared. Please continue to keep the people of Israel, Palestine and the Occupied Territories in your prayers as they struggle towards a difficult resolution. Our Parish pilgrimage travelled in support of the McCabe Trust, a charity that works to provide aid for Palestinian Christians. **Only a small number of the Parish were able to travel to the Holy Land, but if you would like to support McCabe's charitable endeavours, olive-wood rosaries and cards with flowers from Galilee and Jerusalem will be on sale for a minimum donation of £1 after our Masses this weekend. Do please give what you can. Thank you.**

HOSPITALITY IS A WELCOME GIFT

Our parish should be a place of welcome for all and a place where people can feel at home. It's a joy to celebrate our diversity as we gather together at the weekend, each with our own gifts and strengths, but for people who are new or are unfamiliar with the parish, the characteristics of our church can be quite different: Where's the Mass setting? Why is there no organist? What happens at Children's Liturgy? Our small team of greeters helps make our church feel even more welcoming by meeting people at the door and helping them with practical matters, such as showing people to a seat when the church seems crowded and letting them know where the loo is, for example. **Thankfully we have a few people who help to welcome but we need more people to volunteer to help with this important ministry of hospitality.** If you can help in this way please see Fr. CALLING ALL SINGERS – please note we rehearse the music for each Family Mass at 10am. If you'd like to come along and sing please join us, as it would be great to have a choir ready for our Christmas Masses.

We will celebrate the first Mass of Christmas at a 6pm Family Mass on Monday 24th. Fr. Adrian is hoping that we can put on a nativity play at that Mass. There won't be any lines to learn as there's a musical backing track but we do need the typical cast of nativity characters from among our children and some volunteer parents to help rehearse and run-through the movement. **Please see Fr. Adrian if you or our child would like to help. Please be aware that no volunteers have come forward so far so the proposed nativity mime is looking less likely to happen unless parents come forward in the next two weeks.**

Following tremendous support last year our Annual Appeal this Christmas will again support the work of our local Probation Office by providing food parcels for ex-offenders on very low incomes so they can have a little extra help and support at Christmas. Probation officers work directly with offenders to tackle the causes of their offending behaviour, enabling them to turn their lives around and rehabilitate them back into the community. **Providing support in this way helps ex-offenders to remain ex-offenders so please consider helping if you can.** Please box up **non-perishable** items of food so that our church can show the gospel values of care that can turn wayward lives around.
