**Please note:** we will be celebrating the Parish **First Holy Communion Mass at 12.15 on Sunday 12 May**, a Holy Communion Mass of Thanksgiving for Pentecost at 10.30 on 19 May and our **Confirmation Mass at 6pm on Saturday 15 June**. Those Masses will be larger in number than normal, with half of the seats reserved downstairs, as we welcome visiting family and friends. If you think Mass will be especially busy you may like to consider attending one of our other Masses that weekend, but please note the whole of the balcony area will be designated for unreserved seating.
