In the name of the Father...

This Trinity Sunday cannot pass without mention of the horrific attack upon the life of Drummer Lee Rigby. **Any violence committed with the conviction that a loving Creator calls for such acts in His name, can never be condoned.** Our hearts and prayers reach out to Lee's family, friends and colleagues at such a time of tragedy. Although the streets of Woolwich are far from our own neighbourhood, one of Lee's killers was born in Lambeth, bringing the tragedy nearer to home.

When the horror of the situation unfolded and the true nature of the attack became clear, community and faith leaders from around Lambeth were called together at Brixton Police station last week. The upset and tension around the room was palpable, both at the horror of what had just happened, but at the fear of what might come - in continuation, or in reprisal.

Along with representatives from Faiths Together in Lambeth and other groups, I spoke in praise of our local faith assemblies and of how they help to shape our community for the good. Although there was a fear of how some individuals may misunderstand the work of faith groups, the prevailing sense was one of how each minister and community leader should help to bring a message of hope and tolerance in a time of turmoil.

Our own little community in Streatham Hill seldom sees such turmoil, but, as a community of Christians we hold firm in our belief in the Holy Trinity - the One God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In a world that so often prefers the darkness to the light, may we hold firm in our faith that the true Light of the World shines out, with the power of the Holy Spirit leading us to the heart of our Father God, calling us to help build a kingdom of peace.
