News from Fr. Adrian ...

It is with a sense of loss and a sense of trust and hope in the Lord's will for us all, that I announce this weekend how, following the sudden death of Fr. Tom Heneghan, Archbishop Peter has asked me to become Parish Priest of Corpus Christi, Brixton Hill. This news is being announced in both parishes this weekend, with the move planned for mid-September. **I was surprised, honoured and humbled to hear the news and am sad to leave St Simon & St Jude** but blessed to be able to help lead Corpus Christi through their grief into the ways the Lord will guide them in the future. **The future of our parish is certain**, but it is not yet certain when the announcement can be made of who my successor will be, as Archbishop Peter is making careful plans. Both parishes will be experiencing loss and the sense of the unknown and the new, so please keep us all in your prayers – with my prayers for you.

News from Pope Francis...

The Congregation for Divine Worship has announced that **Saint Joseph will be remembered in the Eucharistic Prayers of the Latin Rite from now on.** It is understood that this decision was prompted by requests from around the world. It has been confirmed by Pope Francis and had previously received the approval of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI so that, after the name of the Virgin Mary, the words **"with blessed Joseph, her spouse"** will be added. Blessed John XXIII had added the name of St Joseph to the first Eucharistic Prayer, known as the Roman Canon, in the 1960s. The new decree inserts his name into Eucharistic Prayers II, III and IV. The official Latin texts of the Mass have already been approved and our Diocesan website has confirmed the information.
