Collections

Thank you: our collections over the last **fortnight** raised:
£767.27 for the running of the Parish and
£400.23 in loose cash for Fr. Adrian's leaving gift
These sums include monies given in Gift Aid envelopes. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account.

Our second collection today is to help support the needs of the Apostleship of the Sea (AoS) following the celebration of Sea Sunday, when the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea. Many of us have never stopped to consider how important seafarers are to our standard of living. Without them we would not have most of the items we use in our everyday lives. Many of these seafarers are unable to practice their faith due to long periods away from home, whilst others are denied basic rights and working conditions that we take for granted. Today's second collection is our opportunity to support the work of AoS, the official maritime welfare agency of the Catholic Church in Great Britain. This annual collection is absolutely vital to enable AoS to continue its work with seafarers. Please give generously and remember seafarers in your prayers. A note for Gift Aid donors: as previously notified, if you wish to give by Gift Aid to the second collection please complete in full the AoS envelope available at our masses this weekend. The manila envelope is for the parish first and second (maintenance) collection. Only monies given in loose cash or in the coloured AoS envelope will be sent directly to the AoS for the Sea Sunday collection. Any donation in the parish manila envelope will always be divided between the charitable work for the parish and the maintenance programme. In summary, to give by Gift Aid to the AoS please use their envelope or place loose cash in the second collection, to give by Gift Aid to the maintenance programme please use the parish manila envelope. Please note: this practice applies to every second collection to enable people to support the parish or chosen charity.

News from Vatican Radio...

"It has been announced that **Blessed Pope John Paul II, and Blessed Pope John XXIII are to be canonised.** No dates for the canonisation ceremonies have been given yet. Pope Francis approved a second miracle attributed to the John Paul II who was beatified in May of 2011. The announcement of Pope John XXIII's canonisation comes just a month after the 50th anniversary of his death." Speculation in the British media thinks it likely that the canonisation ceremonies



will occur before the end of the year, most probably on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, December 8, but official news will be given as soon as it is available.
