Fr. Habte has been working full time at St. George's Hospital two days a week, visiting the wards, celebrating mass in the hospital chapel and on these days he is also on-call for any emergencies needing a Priest there.

At the moment Fr. Habte will be joining us at the weekend only, but, we are continuing to have our morning prayer as usual
