Blessed sacrament Procession 2013.

The annual Procession of the Blessed Sacrament will take place on Saturday 12th October. It was started in 2011 to mark the first anniversary of the Beatification of Blessed John Henry Newman. It links London's two Catholic cathedrals, Westminster and Southwark. Starting at 1.30pm at Westminster Cathedral, crossing the Thames at Lambeth Bridge and finishing at St. George's cathedral, Southwark at approximately 2.45pm.

The Rosary Crusade of Reparation also takes place on 12th October.

Anyone wishing to take part needs to assemble at Westminster Cathedral at 2.15pm ready to walk to the Brompton Oratory, arriving there at approximately 5pm.
