The Month of October.

This is the month for prayer for world mission and the Rosary. Those who recite the decades of the Rosary in the Church, or as a family, or as a religious community, or as a group of the faithful, may gain a plenary indulgence daily. In other circumstances a partial indulgence may be gained. When we celebrate open "World Mission Sunday", Christians in the world will reflect over their common responsibility with regard to the evangelization of the world.

This weekend is the third week of the annual Mass Count, when the number of people attending Mass here is noted.

As previously asked, will two volunteers please arrange to count everyone when the collection is taken and enter the total on the sheet which will be left on the table at the back of the Church!

School Reference Forms.

At the back of the Church are Enrolment Forms which are to be completed and returned by 3rd November so that the preparation programme can begin.

Children should be at least seven years of age before making their First Holy Communion and should be in year 3-4 of primary education.
